### **New Students Online Registration for Credit and Non-Credit Courses**

To date, approximately 3,600 students, including just over 430 new students, have successfully reserved credited university courses via the new Banner online registration process.

Please be advised, however, that there will be a slight adjustment in the process to accommodate full registration for new students who are simultaneously taking both credited courses and select academic enhancement courses, or non-credited courses (formerly identified as college prep). These are the students who have not achieved all requirements for full enrolment into a university degree programme.

For example, a student may have been advised for the following mixture of credited and non-credited courses for Fall 2018 and so will have to register separately for these courses:-

***ENGL 119 Writing and Rhetoric I (3 credits)***

***SPAN 103 Introductory Spanish I (3 credits)***

***ACCA 105 Financial Accounting I (3 credits)***

***HIST 013 Academic Enhancement History (0 Credits)***

***MATH 048 Academic Enhancement Mathematics III (0 Credits)***

As stated earlier, Banner is being used to reserve credited university courses. However, an announcement is forthcoming regarding how new students are to register online for academic enhancement courses offered via Continuing Education and Lifelong Learning (CELEARN). University of The Bahamas (UB) is, in fact, expanding access to these courses and **students will be able to complete their course reservations by the end of the week and in time for the start of classes next week.**
